

Tour: The golden fans

Tour features:

What to take with: *solid shoes, rain jacket, warm clothes*



Season: *15 June – 15 September* Duration: 11 days

Distance of the tour: 110km Altitude: *max 3812m.*

Services included in the tour: guide service, full pension, porter, local transportation, donkey with donkey handler.



Itinerary

Day – In Penjikent, sightseeing. Trip to the seven lakes. Overnight at homestays.

1. Day – Hiking from the 4th lake to the 7th lake. Overnight in tent on the shore of the lake.
3. Day – Hiking around Marguzor Lake and preparation to overcome Tavasang Pass. Overnight at tent on the shore of the 7th lake.
4. Day – Overcoming Tavasang Pass (3307m). Overnight closed to the Sarimat river.
5. Day – Overcoming Munora Pass (3500 m). Overnight in Nangut gorge.
6. Day – Hiking to Archamaidan river in Archamaidan valley. Overnight in tents.
7. Day – Overcoming Dukdon Pass (3812m). Overnight in tents
8. Day – Hiking the Karakul lake along till Saratog village. Overnight at traditional homestay.
9. Day – Hiking from Saratog village to Iskanderkul Lake. Overnight on the shore of the lake in tents.
10. Day – Hiking around Iskanderkul Lake: Waterfall, 5 springs, Zmeinoe Lake.
11. День – Coming back day.

Fan Mountains

Fan Mountains are located between the Hissar and Zerafshan Ranges, west of the Anzob pass. This fabulous alpine area is one of the best kept secrets in Central Asia. Among the most beautiful and interesting peaks (from a mountaineer's point of view) are Chapdara (5050m), Bodkhona (5138m), Zamok(4800), Maria(4970), and Zindon(4800). Both the good and the ordinary routes on the south and west sides of Chimtarga (5487m), the highest peak of Fan Mountains, lead to its top. Besides the high peaks and narrow valleys with their noisy streams, there are also about 30 clear lakes of a variety of colours. To the south of the main range is Lake Iskanderkul (2,5km in length, 1 km in wide, and about 72m deep. The Alaudin lakes are a group of reservoirs upstreams in the Pasrud valley.
